About 54 % teachers are in favour of good response concerned with the design of curriculum according to students understanding power, and only 29% teachers are in favour of satisfactory response with the same situation.

About 32 % and 63% teachers are in favour of curriculum, that it is well organized and easy to follow excellent and good response respectively and 04 % are in favour of satisfactory response. Teachers have highly accepted that the resources/ materials required for teaching the curriculum are in plenty.

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ANALYSIS OF ALUMNI FEEDBACK

We collect feedback from alumni students of Arts & Science faculty. The feedback form for alumni students include ten questions. The questions are mainly concerned with overall facilities provided to the students during their study period and its utility to them for their academic development. The questions include infrastructural facilities , academic facilities , helpfulness of teachers and administrative staff , availability of books and magazines along with seating place in library , teaching ability of faculty , curriculum , freedom for optional subjects selection and overall experience as a student.

The alumni feedback forms are analyzed by the committee. The outcomes of analysis are as follows.

About 90 % alumni students have accepted that the infrastructural facilities provided by the institute are excellent, only 10 % are in favor of good and satisfactory response , and no one has selected unsatisfactory portion . The students have highly accepted that the academic facilities provided by the institute is very good . About 50 % alumni students have opted excellent response, & 50 % good response concerned with the helpfulness of teachers and administrative staff during their study period.

As per alumni students experience concerned with library books , magazines and availability of seating space , 30 % students have opted excellent response, about 40 % have opted good response and only 30 % have opted satisfactory response , but nobody is unsatisfactory . About teaching ability of the faculty , alumni students have highly accepted the ability to teach the curriculum is excellent and no one is unsatisfactory.

About 47 % alumni students have opted excellent response and 53 % students have opted good response concerned with curriculum . 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Analysis of Feedback given by Parents.


Academic year 2018-19

About these two questions parents are not fully happy and they have expressed their worries about the carrier after the completion of programmes.
